Brief Description of the Activities

<u>The Six A's of Positive Parenting</u> – Accountability and Authority Mrs. Ling was invited to explain the 6A Moral training, and more than 60 parents participated. This improved the interaction and relationship between parents and adolescent children. Improved mental health of parents was observed.

Support activities - [The Six A's of Positive Parenting] Parent Practical Workshop Three follow-up workshops were held, with approximately ten parents participating in each workshop to discuss, learn, and practice skills while interacting with their children. In order to

understand and apply principles in The Six A's of Positive Parenting.

To improve the relationship between parents and adolescent children.

To learn emotional management skills and the correct way to care for their children.

To learn how to communicate with teenagers.

To be aware of some common misunderstandings.

Student Outcomes/ Evaluation Results

Through parent questionnaires, we learned that most participating parents understood and paid more attention to the mental health of their children. They felt supported and encouraged by the school. After this activity, they felt it was easier to let go and accept and understand their children's behavioral and psychological changes with a more open heart. They hoped that the school will organize more similar activities in the future to alleviate the pressure and difficulties they face in educating their children.
